

# Boat Access to Canal A Sunset Beach, NC

- You will want to put in your boat at the Marina on Ocean Isle Beach (see arrow on the first map below). This is one island over (to the East) from Sunset Beach.
- When you come over the bridge to Ocean Isle, you'll take a sharp left turn around to the boat slips (they're literally under the causeway bridge).
- There is plenty of room to leave your boat trailer back at the house on 6th street on the left side of the front yard.



- Put your boat in at Ocean Isle Marina and head due West down the Intercoastal towards Sunset Beach. Pass the Eastern Channel which goes to the ocean.
- Follow the Intercoastal to where you're in good eye sight of the Sunset Bridge.
- You will then take a LEFT down a rather large channel (be careful in low tide) and follow this channel to Tubbs Inlet (see arrow below).
- Once you're near the inlet, you'll take a Sharp RIGHT into the small channel that leads to the four private canals (see arrow below). Note: There is an extreme low spot at the entrance to the channel. Go slow once you enter the channel as it is a no wake zone (and is shallow in very low tide).
- When you get to the end of the channel, take a LEFT into Canal A. Our dock is the second from the end on the RIGHT. Cleats and tie off ropes should be on the dock ready for your use.
